




STEP ONE

Send your visitors a link to securely provide information on their health status prior to arriving at your location. Therefore™ will automatically calculate their responses and provide them information on whether they have been permitted to arrive at your office, or told to wait until their situation improves.

STEP TWO

Arrive at your office, and show proof of your acceptance from Therefore™. Your team can verify their email matches the record you have in your system.

STEP THREE


Step in front of the TASK and have the unit confirm Temperature, Mask, and for Employees, Facial Recognition as well. This is the final check before allowing that person into your office environment, and helps to ensure everyone remains safe.

STEP FOUR

Therefore will tie together all data from the eForms and the TASK into a singular location, for contact tracing purposes.

STEP FIVE

Generate reports which will help show information on how safe your offices are, as well as generate any reporting needed should you need to provide details of who has been in your office and what condition they are in. Information is stored on Canadian Data Centres, and is secure.



DOUBLE PROTECTION

Secure your facilities by using the TASK, which detects any abnormal temperatures. It will also detect if a mask is worn to ensure the regulation is followed. You can even set up facial recognition, which will still work when masks are worn, to help ensure the safety of everyone at your location.
